Ms. Friedman was scheduled to provide speech services to a client on November 15, 2015. Ms. Friedman went to the client's home, but did not see the client or provide speech services to the client on November 15, 2015; however, she signed the client's name on the visit note. By signing the client's name on the visit note on November 15, 2015, documentation submitted to her employer indicated that she had provided speech services to the client when she had not.
