

**CONSENT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
LUREEN TAYLOR
AND
THE OHIO BOARD OF SPEECH-LANGUAGE
PATHOLOGY AND AUDIOLOGY**

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between **LUREEN TAYLOR** and the **OHIO BOARD OF SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY AND AUDIOLOGY**, a state agency charged with enforcing Chapter 4753 of the Ohio Revised Code.

LUREEN TAYLOR voluntarily enters into this Agreement being fully informed of her rights under Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code, including the right to representation by counsel and the right to a formal adjudicative hearing on the issues considered herein.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT contains the entire Agreement between the parties, there being no other Agreement of any kind, verbal or otherwise, which varies the terms of this CONSENT AGREEMENT.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into on the basis of the following stipulations, admissions, and understandings:

1. The OHIO BOARD OF SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY AND AUDIOLOGY is empowered by Section 4753.10, Ohio Revised Code, to reprimand or place on probation a speech-language pathologist or audiologist, or suspend, revoke, or refuse to issue or renew the license of a speech-language pathologist or audiologist for any of the enumerated violations.
2. The OHIO BOARD OF SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY AND AUDIOLOGY enters into this CONSENT AGREEMENT in lieu of further formal proceedings based upon the violation of Section 4753.10, Ohio Revised Code, set forth in the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing issued by the BOARD on August 8, 1997, and attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference. The BOARD expressly reserves the right to institute additional formal proceedings based upon any other violations of

Chapter 4753 of the Revised Code whether occurring before or after the effective date of this AGREEMENT.

3. LUREEN TAYLOR holds a license to practice speech-language pathology [SP-1547] in the State of Ohio. This license was issued by the BOARD on or about December 1, 1976.
4. LUREEN TAYLOR admits the factual and legal allegations set forth in the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing issued by the BOARD on August 8, 1997, and attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference herein.

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth and in lieu of any further formal proceedings at this time, LUREEN TAYLOR, knowingly and voluntarily agrees with the OHIO BOARD OF SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY AND AUDIOLOGY (hereinafter BOARD) to the following terms, conditions and limitations:

- A. LUREEN TAYLOR shall obey all federal, state and local laws, and all rules governing the practice of speech-language pathology in Ohio.
- B. LUREEN TAYLOR is hereby REPRIMANDED for the activity set forth in the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing issued by the BOARD on August 8, 1997. This REPRIMAND shall be entered in the BOARD'S journal and in MS. TAYLOR's licensure file.
- C. The BOARD agrees not to proceed with further action against LUREEN TAYLOR for any of the conduct described in this CONSENT AGREEMENT as long as she remains in compliance with the terms and conditions of this AGREEMENT.
- D. LUREEN TAYLOR hereby releases the State of Ohio, the BOARD, and its members, officers, employees and/or agents of either, jointly and severally from any liability which arises from the within matter.

If, in the discretion of the BOARD, MS. TAYLOR appears to have breached any terms or conditions of this CONSENT AGREEMENT, the BOARD reserves the right to

institute formal disciplinary proceedings against LUREEN TAYLOR, for any and all possible violations or breaches, including, but not limited to, alleged violations of the laws of Ohio occurring before the effective date of this AGREEMENT.

MS. TAYLOR acknowledges that she has had an opportunity to ask questions concerning the terms of this AGREEMENT and that all questions asked have been answered in a satisfactory manner.

Any action initiated by the BOARD based on the alleged violations of this CONSENT AGREEMENT shall comply with the Administrative Procedures Act, Chapter 119, Ohio Revised Code.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43, Ohio Revised Code. It is expressly understood that this CONSENT AGREEMENT is subject to ratification by the BOARD and shall become effective upon the last date of signature below.
