

**CONSENT AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
LISA RAE LAMB  
AND  
THE OHIO BOARD OF SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY AND AUDIOLOGY**

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between LISA RAE LAMB (hereinafter "MS. LAMB") and the Ohio Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology (hereinafter "BOARD"), the state agency charged with enforcing Chapter 4753 of the Ohio Revised Code, and all rules promulgated thereunder.

MS. LAMB voluntarily enters into this CONSENT AGREEMENT, being fully informed of her rights under Chapter 119, Ohio Revised Code, including her right to representation by counsel and her right to a formal adjudicative hearing on the issues which are the subject of this CONSENT AGREEMENT.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT contains the entire agreement between the parties, there being no other agreement of any kind, verbal or otherwise, which varies the terms of this CONSENT AGREEMENT.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into on the basis of the following statements and understandings:

1. MS. LAMB holds a conditional license to practice speech-language pathology [CSP-96056] in the state of Ohio. This license was issued by the BOARD on or about October 6, 1995.
2. On or about August 21, 1995, Ms. LAMB completed and signed the Supervisor Professional Experience Plan listing as her supervisor Kathleen M. Staugler. This plan was received by the Board on August 22, 1995. The plan provided that MS. LAMB'S

Professional Experience would take place at the Simon-Kenton School for Mental Retardation, 705 North Ida Street, Kenton, Ohio 43326, under the supervision of Ms. Staugler, commencing August 29, 1995 and ending May 30, 1996.

3. MS. LAMB commenced the practice of Speech-Language Pathology on August 29, 1995, without Board approval of the Supervised Experience Plan. At that time, Ms. Lamb was not properly licensed.
4. From August 29, 1995 through October 6, 1995, MS. LAMB engaged in the practice of speech language pathology while not properly licensed. This conduct is a violation of Section 4753.10 and 4753.02 of the Ohio Revised Code. Pursuant to Section 4753.10:

\*\*\*the board of speech-language pathology and audiology may reprimand or place on probation a speech-language pathologist or audiologist or suspend, revoke, or refuse to issue or renew the license of a speech-language pathologist or audiologist. Disciplinary actions may be taken by the board for conduct that may result from but not necessarily be limited to:

\* \* \*

- (M) Violating this chapter or any lawful order given or rule adopted by the board; \*\*\*

Unlicensed practice of speech language pathology is a violation of Section 4753.02 which states, in pertinent part:

No person shall practice ... the profession of speech-language pathology ... unless the person is licensed under this chapter.

5. MS. LAMB has chosen not to dispute the allegations as stated above in paragraphs 2 through 4.

Based upon the above statements and understandings, the BOARD and MS.

LAMB agree as follows:

- A. MS. LAMB shall obey all federal, state, and local laws, and all rules governing the practice of speech-language pathology in Ohio.
- B. MS. LAMB shall not supervise anyone who performs speech-language pathology services unless that person holds a current and valid license to practice speech-language pathology in the state of Ohio.
- C. MS. LAMB is hereby REPRIMANDED for the activity described in paragraphs 2 through 4 above. This REPRIMAND shall be entered in the Board's journal and in MS. LAMB's licensure file.
- D. The BOARD agrees not to proceed with further action against MS. LAMB for any of the conduct described in this CONSENT AGREEMENT as long as she remains in compliance with the terms and conditions of this CONSENT AGREEMENT.
- E. MS. LAMB waives all her rights under Chapter 119, Ohio Revised Code, as they relate to matters which are the subject of this CONSENT AGREEMENT.
- F. MS. LAMB waives any and all claims or causes of action she may have against the state of Ohio, the Board, and members, officers, employees and/or agents of either, arising out of matters which are the subject of this CONSENT AGREEMENT.

Notwithstanding paragraphs D and E above, if, in the discretion of the BOARD, MS. LAMB appears to have breached any terms or conditions of this CONSENT AGREEMENT, the BOARD reserves the right to institute formal disciplinary proceedings against MS. LAMB, including, but not limited to, proceedings based on the conduct described in paragraphs 2 through 4.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT shall become effective upon the last date of signature below. Further, this CONSENT AGREEMENT shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Ohio Revised Code Section 149.43.
