AGENDA

Motion #2

Mr. Porter moved to accept the minutes of the June 15, 2009, board meeting, as corrected. Ms. Embry seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

CHAIRPERSON'S COMMENTS

Dr. Ward-Gravely

- Patricia Zurlinden was unable to attend due to an excused absence. Her term as a Speech-Language Pathology Board Member will end September 26, 2009. She will not be seeking reappointment.
- The Board office is now fully staffed. Beverly Wilkinson was introduced as the Temporary Licensing Administrator. She was complimented for the great job she has done.

EXECUTIVE SESSION - Personnel Matters

Motion #3

Dr. Kukula moved to enter Executive Session for the purpose of considering the appointment, employment, dismissal, promotion, demotion or compensation of a public employee pursuant to Section 121.22(G)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code. Ms. Embry seconded the motion, which passed by roll call vote as follows:

Dr. Levenfus: yes; Ms. Embry: yes; Mr. Good: yes; Dr. Kukula: yes; Ms. Leppla: yes; Mr. Porter: yes; Dr. Ward-Gravely: yes.

The Board went into Executive Session at 9:47 A.M. and invited Mr. Thornton to remain in attendance. Assistant Attorney General Megan Boiarsky joined at 9:56 A.M.

The Board returned to Public Session at 11:22 A.M.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Mr. Thornton submitted a written report of significant activities occurring since the last Board meeting. He provided updates regarding the:

- Board's approved budget for FY2010 through FY 2011 and the impact of budget cuts;
- Student Permit program;
- Postponement of Board Consolidation for back-office support services due to budget cuts;
- Proposed Legislation under House Bill 215;
- Board Audit which will be reviewed with the Senior Auditor at the October 16, 2009 board meeting;
- Ethics training for board members every two years;

- Office move being postponed due to budget cuts;
- Two board vacancies occurring on September 26, 2009. Ms. Leppla was recommended for reappointment for a full term. The Ohio Speech and Hearing Association was notified of these board vacancies and was provided the contact information to the Governor's office for appointment recommendations;
- Changes to the state travel rules occurring on October 1, 2009.

INVESTIGATIONS

A. Executive Session

Motion #4

Ms. Embry moved to enter Executive Session for the purpose of discussing proposed disciplinary action against licensees, involving pending or imminent court action under R.C. §121.22.(G)(3), and which requires that such matters be kept confidential under R.C. §149.43.(A)(2). Ms. Leppla seconded the motion, which passed by roll call vote as follows: Dr. Levenfus: yes; Ms. Embry: yes; Mr. Good: yes; Dr. Kukula: yes; Ms. Leppla: yes; Mr. Porter: yes; Dr. Ward-Gravelly: yes.

The Board went into Executive Session at 11:54 A.M. and invited the board staff to remain in attendance.

The Board returned to Public Session at 12:15 P.M.

B. Board Actions

2009-16

This case involves unlicensed practice by a speech-language pathologist due to failing to renew in a timely manner by December 31, 2008. Per the June 15, 2009 board meeting a Reprimand Letter was issued to the Respondent informing him/her to renew on time in the future, to update the Board of any address change, and to complete 5 hours of continuing education in the area of ethics. The Respondent completed the required 5 hours in ethics and will be audited for continuing education hours for the next renewal cycle.

Accordingly, the Investigative Review Group recommended closing case 2009-16.

Motion #5

Ms. Leppla moved to accept the Investigative Review Group's recommendation in case 2009-16. Dr. Kukula seconded the motion. Dr. Ward-Gravelly abstained. Dr. Levenfus abstained. The motion passed uncontested.

2009-19

This case involves unlicensed practice by a speech-language pathologist due to failing to renew in a timely manner by December 31, 2008. Per the March 5, 2009 board meeting a Consent Agreement was issued to suspend for thirty-eight (38) days staying half. The Respondent agreed to the terms and signed the Consent Agreement.

Accordingly, the Investigative Review Group recommended the following in case 2009-19:

- **Review and approve a redacted copy of the signed Consent Agreement and then close the case.**

Motion #6

Mr. Good moved to accept the Investigative Review Group's recommendations in case 2009-19. Ms. Embry seconded the motion. Dr. Ward-Gravely abstained. Dr. Levenfus abstained. The motion passed uncontested.

Case 2009-20

This case involves unlicensed practice by a speech-language pathologist due to failing to renew in a timely manner, by December 31, 2008. Per the June 15, 2009 board meeting a Consent Agreement was issued to suspend for forty days staying half; to complete an additional 5 hours of continuing education in the area of ethics, to be completed ninety days from the date the Board approves the Consent Agreement; and will be audited for continuing education hours for the next 2 renewal cycles. The Respondent agreed to the terms and signed the Consent Agreement.

Accordingly, the Investigative Review Group recommended the following in case 2009-20:

- **Review and approve a redacted copy of the signed Consent Agreement and then close the case.**

Motion #7

Mr. Good moved to accept the Investigative Review Group's recommendations in case 2009-20. Ms. Leppla seconded the motion. Dr. Ward-Gravely abstained. Dr. Levenfus abstained. The motion passed uncontested.

Case 2009-21

This case involves unlicensed practice by a speech-language pathologist due to failing to renew in a timely manner, by December 31, 2008. Per the June 15, 2009 board meeting a Consent Agreement was issued to suspend for sixty-eight (68) days staying half, to complete an additional 15 hours of continuing education in the area of ethics to be completed ninety days from the date the Board approves the Consent Agreement and the Respondent will be audited for continuing education hours for the next 3 renewal cycles. The Respondent agreed to the terms and signed the Consent Agreement.

Accordingly, the Investigative Review Group recommended the following in case 2009-21:

- **Review and approve a redacted copy of the signed Consent Agreement and then close the case.**

Motion #8

Ms. Leppla moved to accept the Investigative Review Group's recommendations in case 2009-21. Ms. Embry seconded the motion. Dr. Ward-Gravely abstained. Dr. Levenfus abstained. The motion passed uncontested.

Case 2009-22

This case involves falsification of a renewal application, insufficient continuing education for renewal, and non compliance to the 2008 Continuing Education Audit by a speech-language pathologist. Per the June 15, 2009 board meeting a Reprimand Letter was issued to the Respondent informing him/her that his/her license is no longer active and that he/she cannot practice. The Respondent has not practiced speech-language pathology for the past eleven years. The Respondent voluntarily surrendered his/her license to the Board.

Accordingly, the Investigative Review Group recommended closing case 2009-22.

Motion #9

Mr. Good moved to accept the Investigative Review Group's recommendation in case 2009-22. Ms. Leppla seconded the motion. Dr. Ward-Gravely abstained. Dr. Levenfus abstained. The motion passed uncontested.

Case 2009-25

This case involves unlicensed practice by a speech-language pathologist due to failing to renew in a timely manner, by December 31, 2008. At the June 15, 2009 board meeting, the Board reviewed and approved the Consent Agreement, which was signed by all parties.

Accordingly, the Investigative Review Group recommended closing case 2009-25.

Motion #10

Mr. Good moved to accept the Investigative Review Group's recommendation in case 2009-25. Ms. Embry seconded the motion. Dr. Ward-Gravely abstained. Dr. Levenfus abstained. The motion passed uncontested.

2009-27

This case involves a speech-language pathologist who did not comply with the 2008 Continuing Education Audit due to extenuating circumstances and is currently living out of state. Per the June 15, 2009 board meeting an Advisory Letter was issued to the Respondent informing him/her to notify the Board if and when he/she returns to Ohio to practice. At that time, he/she is to comply with the 2008 Audit.

Accordingly, the Investigative Review Group recommended the following in case 2009-27.

- **Issue a formal Consent Agreement asking the Respondent to agree to the terms listed in the Advisory Letter and to the following additional terms:**
 - **To voluntarily surrender his/her license.**
 - **To notify the Board of his/her return to Ohio and to comply with the conditions stated in the Consent Agreement for reinstatement.**

Motion #11

Ms. Embry moved to accept the Investigative Review Group's recommendations in case 2009-27. Ms. Leppla seconded the motion. Dr. Ward-Gravely abstained. Dr. Levenfus abstained. The motion passed uncontested.

2010-01

This case involves unlicensed practice by a conditional speech-language pathologist due to failing to submit the Supervised Professional Experience Plan in a timely manner. The Respondent also did not submit the Report and Contacts Log in a timely manner.

Accordingly, the Investigative Review Group recommended the following in case 2010-01:

- **Issue a Consent Agreement based on the following terms and conditions:**
 - **The Respondent shall complete a new Supervised Professional Experience Plan reflecting an ending date of 1/31/2010.**
 - **The Respondent is to submit the Report and Contacts Log within thirty days of completing his/her new plan.**
 - **Once the Respondent obtains full licensure, he/she will be audited for continuing education hours for the next two renewal cycles.**

Motion #12

Mr. Porter moved to accept the changes as amended in case 2010-01. Ms. Embry seconded the motion. Dr. Ward-Gravely abstained. Dr. Levenfus abstained. The motion passed uncontested.

2010-02

This case involves a conditional speech-language pathologist who did not submit his/her Report and Contacts Log in a timely manner.

Accordingly the Investigative Review Group recommended the following in case 2010-02:

- **Issue a Consent Agreement stating that in addition to the required twenty hours of continuing education, the Respondent is to complete 5 hours of continuing education in the area of documentation and record keeping. The 5 hours must be submitted to the Board office ninety days from the date the Board approves the Consent Agreement.**

Ms. Leppla moved to accept the changes as amended in case 2010-02. Ms. Embry seconded the motion. Dr. Ward-Gravely abstained. Dr. Levenfus abstained. The motion passed uncontested.

- On July 14, 2009 the Board learned that the Ohio Department of Education ("ODE") amendment was not included in the budget bill. The proposed amendment would have moved licensure of student permit holders from the Board's jurisdiction over to the ODE.
- The Board focused all of its resources on completing its review and issuing credentials to all eligible applicants, within 14 days from the date of receipt of the applications. A total of thirty-three (33) applications were approved.
- The Board issued a letter to Mr. Louis Staffilino, Associate Superintendent with the ODE and Erik Roush, the Governor's Policy Advisor on Education, confirming the Board's desire to resume discussions regarding the proposed revisions to the student permit rules.

- A. Discussion to consider breaking down OAC 4753-3-10(E)(2) (Exempt practice; renewal) into four parts for the re-licensure process will occur at the Rules Committee meeting in October 2009.
