INVESTIGATIONS

A. Executive Session

B. Board Actions

2013-27

This case involves a speech-language pathologist who was terminated from his PRN position of a long term care facility for having engaged in unprofessional conduct with a female co-worker during the course of employment and while engaged in the practice of speech-language pathology and audiology. The employer reported the termination to the Board office.

Accordingly, the Investigative Review Group recommends the following in this case:

Due to Respondent's admissions and for violation of Ohio Revised Code sections 4753.10(I)(M), and Ohio Administrative Code sections 4753-3-08(I)(M) and 4753-9-01(B)(1), unprofessional and unethical conduct, offer a Consent Agreement based on the following terms and conditions:

- Reprimand;
- Complete a minimum of 5 continuing education hours in the area of ethics related to professional relationships in the workplace, cultural competency or interpersonal working relationships;
- Submit proof of the 5 hours within 60 days from the date the Board approves the Consent Agreement. These 5 hours will not be applicable towards the 20 continuing education hours required for the 2013-2014 licensure biennium for renewal.

The Respondent agreed to the above terms and signed the Consent Agreement. **Accordingly, the Investigative Review Group recommends approval the Consent Agreement, effective today, and closing this case.**

Senior Assistant Attorney General Melissa L. Wilburn advised the Board on procedures for conducting administrative hearings. She noted that the Board's next hearing will be at the August board meeting.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

A. Rules Committee – Ms. Tammy Brown

Ms. Brown reported that there were no updates for the Rules Committee.

B. Professional Competency Committee – Dr. Linda Wellman

Dr. Wellman reported that the Professional Competency Committee (PCC) met after the May board meeting and discussed several strategic planning initiatives. The PCC will be meeting immediately following the June meeting to review survey questions regarding the service delivery model/scope of practice for speech-language pathology, licensure renewal questions, and streamlining the licensure application process of members of the military and their spouse.

C. Policy and Procedure Committee – Ms. Amy Thorpe Wiley

Ms. Thorpe Wiley reported that there were no updates from the Policy and Procedure Committee.

BOARD BUSINESS

A. SLP Caseload/Shortage Workgroup

The Board received an update regarding the speech-language pathology caseload/shortage workgroup. The Board reviewed licensure data and other information that the workgroup discussed at their last meeting. The Board will continue to have representatives attend the workgroup meetings. Three more meetings are scheduled between July and August. The Board will review final recommendations.

B. Audiology Aides – Review of Duties

The Board reviewed a proposal submitted by the Ohio Academy of Audiology regarding changes to the licensure requirements and duties for audiology aides. Ms. Thorpe Wiley assigned this matter to an ad-hoc committee, which will meet during the August board meeting.

C. Music Therapy Bill – HB 546

The Board discussed House Bill 546, which proposes to license music therapists. The Board expressed concern regarding this proposed legislation because of the lack of evidence-based data demonstrating the effectiveness of music therapy. The Board also noted the potential loss of service when music therapy is prescribed to address communication disorders, rather than services from a qualified speech-language pathologist. The Board reviewed the music therapy scope of practice proposed in the bill and expressed concerns over the individuals' qualifications to perform them. The Board also discussed the use of billing codes for speech-language services being used for music therapy.

D. Poll Board Members for Reappointments

Ms. Brown indicated that she plans to seek reappointment to the Board. Her term will expire on September 26, 2014. The Board will inform the Governor's Office of its support for Ms. Brown's reappointment.

E. Final Board Expenditures for FY2014

Motion #13

Ms. Thorpe Wiley moved to approve quote number m4769 dated June 6, 2014, from Brown Enterprise Solutions in the amount of \$1,488.00 for the purchase of eight Dell computer display monitors. Dr. Wellman seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Motion #14

Ms. Thorpe Wiley moved to approve quote number m4794 dated June 13, 2014, from Brown Enterprise Solutions in the amount of \$721.08 for the purchase of two licenses for Adobe Acrobat Professional. Dr. Mitchell seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

F. Board Resolutions

The Board was informed that Guy Naples, the Executive Director of the Delaware Speech and Hearing Center, will be retiring after thirty years of practice. The Board was also informed that Dr. Roberta DePompei, the Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology Program Director at the University of Akron, will be retiring after more than thirty years of practice. Mr. Naples and Dr. DePompei are also former

board members. The Board issued board resolutions in recognition of their outstanding service to the professions.

CORRESPONDENCE

The Board reviewed correspondence issued since the last board meeting. The Board reviewed correspondence from licensed speech-language pathologist Carol Boals. Ms. Boals expressed concerns about the caseload for speech-language pathologists working in the school setting. The Board appreciates Ms. Boals' correspondence and will respond accordingly, especially noting that the caseload issue is under review by the SLP Shortage/Caseload Workgroup.

There were no member concerns.
