**ORC 4753 Revision**

The Board Members reviewed the latest draft of the revisions to ORC 4753. The following changes to the draft were recommended and forwarded to Ms. O'Reilly at the Governmental Affairs Coalition.

Permit

add Student throughout document to read:

Student Permit (Internship permit should read Student Permit throughout)

Line No.

75 any applicant who submits a plan in a manner to be determined by the board by rule and meets all of the following requirements

79 American Speech-Language-Hearing Association

88-89 authorizes the holder to practice speech-language pathology ~~in all respects as~~ determined by board rule as a person

96-98 and the recommendation by the university graduate program. ~~Of the executive director of the board of the permit holders university graduate program~~

99-100 the permit holder may practice ~~independently~~ under the supervision of a speech language pathologist licensed by the board and employed by the university in a manner to be determined by the board by rule (\*removal of independently)

101-102 ~~who is certified by the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association~~

104-105 ~~the board may renew the permit for only one additional two-year period~~ Student permits may be renewed in a manner to be determined by the board by rule

*Extern students and permit holder students should not be held to 4753.10 standards and need a separate added less stringent penalties associated. \*\* the term "permit" to be removed from §4753.10 (A)-(O). add (P)*
