**EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

Expenses are currently within the projected budget. We are completing the encumbered purchases.

The Annual report to the Governor is completed for Board review.

The Annual legislative service commission report was completed and submitted on September 1.

The Consolidation Transition Team has met twice. A proposal was made to consolidate the twenty boards under the Department of Commerce and maintaining Board autonomy. The proposal lacks details at this time. A public hearing on the consolidation was held on September 14 with the Transition Team. Most all of the testimony spoke in opposition to the consolidation of the Boards. Dr. Jeanne Gokcen spoke on behalf of the Governmental Affairs group in opposition to the consolidation.

The Executive Director was off from September 2 to 9.

The Executive Director was reimbursed \$105.50 for the purchase of copier toner cartridges.

In Case C06-06 the Review Group recommended the case be closed since it involved an Ohio Department of Education issue with IEP's

In Case C05-28, the Review Group recommended to close the case for lack of justification.

Cases C06-05 and C06-02 involved supervision of an unlicensed PEY speech-language pathologist by a licensed speech-language pathologist for a period of two months. Both individuals were following ASHA protocol under Pennsylvania licensure rules and failed to follow Ohio law and rules. The PEY speech-language pathologist subsequently applied for conditional licensure and was approved for licensure. The Review Group recommended letters of warning to the two individuals and close the cases

**Motion#7** Dr. Leslie moved to close cases C06-05 and C06-02 and issue letters of warning. Ms. O'Brien seconded the motion, which passed uncontested. Ms. Parsons abstained.

In Case C06-01 the Review Group found no evidence to support allegations against a speech-language pathologist for patient abuse and recommended closing the case.

In Case A05-20, A06-07 the speech-language pathologist/audiologist failed to comply with a request for continuing education audit documentation from the Board for the speech-language pathology and audiology licenses . The Review Group recommended issuing two Notices of Opportunity for a Hearing to this licensee.

**Motion#11** Dr. Leslie moved to issue two Notices of Opportunity for a Hearing in Case A05-20 for failure to comply with the Board's request for continuing education audit documentation for her two licenses. Ms. Zurlinden seconded the motion, which passed uncontested. Ms. Parsons abstained.

In Case A06-08 a speech-language pathologist failed to comply with a request for continuing education audit documentation from the Board relating to four hours of claimed courses. The Review Group recommended issuing a Notice of Opportunity for a Hearing to this licensee.

**CORRESPONDENCE**

Ann Lesko asked if a Speech-Language Pathologist could administer lidocaine spray under a physician's order.

This is permissible under the scope of practice of a Speech-Language Pathologist provided that the Speech-Language Pathologist is trained in the use and administration of lidocaine spray.

Connie Szymczak asked if a tech performs hearing tests in an ENT office, are they legally permitted to interpret the results (write a summary on the audiogram denoting severe and type of loss) and counsel the patients as to how this loss may be secondary to noise exposure or answer any question about the loss at all?

Procedures performed under the supervision of a physician are governed by the Ohio Medical Board. The Ohio Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology does not have jurisdiction over a physician's practice.

Erin L. Miller sent a letter of support for the rule changes relative to the new requirements for a doctoral degree for audiology licensure

## **BOARD BUSINESS**

### **Proposed Rule Changes**

### **Executive Director's evaluation**

### **Music Therapists**

The Board reviewed documentation related to therapies conducted by a music therapist that fell within the scope of practice of a speech-language pathologist. Mr. Setty will send a letter to the organization that certifies music therapists informing them of the scope of practice of speech-language pathologists and the requirement for licensure in the state of Ohio.

The music therapist will be sent a cease and desist order from the Board.

### **Board Meeting Dates for 2006**

Board meeting dates for 2006 will be set at the December 5 Board Meeting.

**Speech-Language Pathologist Issue in MRDD Facility**

The Board requested information from a county Board for MRDD relating to the practice of Speech-Language Pathology by unlicensed staff in one of their facilities. The attorney for the county Board for MRDD replied without answering the questions submitted by the Ohio Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology.

Mr. Setty will send the information on this matter to the State Board for MRDD for follow-up.
