PUBLIC AND PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATIONS' COMMENTS

No comments were presented.

AGENDA

The agenda was presented and reviewed. Amendments were made.

Motion#1 Ms. Shotwell moved to accept the agenda as amended. Dr. Leslie seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

MINUTES

The minutes of the May 6, 2005 Meeting were reviewed and corrected.

Motion#2 Ms. Zurlinden moved to approve the minutes of the May 6, meeting as corrected. Dr. Gleason seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Mr. Setty updated the Board on H.B.66 consolidation legislation. The current bill that was considered by the Senate contains the same language that was in the House version, with the addition of language to include three licensing board executive director's on the transition committee. The Senate ignored the testimony of many professional organizations and boards that opposed the consolidation. No person or organization testified in support of the consolidation. The final budget bill will be voted on by the end of June.

All Board expenses are within budget through May. A surplus of over \$10,000 is anticipated.

The Executive Director recommended the purchase of a high speed, double sided, scanner and supporting software for \$6,000. This will enable the Board to electronically file and store almost all of our records. The remainder of the surplus will be used to purchase supplies.

Motion#3 Ms. Parsons moved to recommend the purchase of the scanner and programming from the FY 2005 surplus. Ms. Shotwell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Auditors have completed their on site work on the FY 2003-2004 audit. The preliminary report shows that more focus and attention has to be paid to policies and procedures. No major problems or issues were noted.

The Executive Director took a vacation from May 21 to June 3.

ASSISTANT ATTORNEY GENERAL'S REPORT

Mr. Chieffo reported on the successful appeal of the Raabe case and the resolution of the Rebecca Conner case.

Motion#4 Dr. Leslie moved to enter Executive Session for the discussion of investigations. Ms. Parsons seconded the motion, which passed by roll call vote as follows: Dr. Mangino yes; Dr Leslie: yes;; Ms. O'Brien :yes; Ms. Parsons: yes; Ms. Shotwell: yes; Ms. Zurlinden: yes; Dr. Gleason: yes.

The Board went into executive session at 9:30 A.M. with the Board staff in attendance.

Motion#5 Ms. Shotwell moved to reenter Public Session. Dr. Leslie seconded the motion, which passed by roll call vote as follows: Dr. Mangino: yes; Dr Leslie: yes; Ms. O'Brien: yes; Ms. Parsons: yes; Ms. Shotwell: yes; Ms. Zurlinden: yes; Dr. Gleason: yes.

The Board returned to Public Session at 9:57 A.M.

The Board approved a request at the May 6th Board Meeting to mail a 119 Notice of Opportunity for Hearing for failing to return a completed renewal application. The licensee returned the completed renewal application before the 119 Notice was mailed. The Review group recommended that the Board withdraw the 119, Notice of Opportunity for Hearing, and close the case.

Motion#6 Dr. Leslie moved to withdraw the 119, Notice of Opportunity for Hearing, and close case AO5-22. Ms. Zurlinden seconded the motion, which passed uncontested. Ms. Parsons abstained.

The Board approved a request at the May 6th Board Meeting to mail a 119 Notice of Opportunity for Hearing, for failing to return a completed renewal application. The 119 was sent on May 27th. The Board received her completed renewal form on June 3, 2005.

The Review group recommended that the Board withdraw the 119, Notice of Opportunity for Hearing, and close the case.

Motion# 7 Dr. Leslie moved to withdraw the 119, Notice of Opportunity for Hearing, and close case AO5-23 Dr. Gleason seconded the motion, which passed uncontested. Ms. Parsons abstained.

Unlicensed practice in a school from January 1, 2005 through May 9, 2005. Licensee signed the Consent Agreement which was offered. The discipline is an 18 week suspension, 9 weeks shall be stayed, and the remaining 9 weeks of the suspension shall be served.

The Review group recommends to accept the consent agreement.

Motion# 8 Dr. Leslie moved to accept the consent agreement in Case A05-25 and close the case. Ms. Shotwell seconded the motion, which passed uncontested. Ms. Parsons abstained

Late Renewals

Four working licensees renewed their licenses in March. Two of the individuals were working part-time. These licensees will be issued letters of warning.

Motion#9 Ms. Parsons moved that individuals that failed to renew by March 31 be referred to the review group for investigation of unlicensed practice. Ms. Zurlinden seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Ms. DiCesare reported that there were three cases opened since the last Board Meeting and four cases were closed. There are a total of seventeen open cases currently.

Rules Committee

The Rules committee met at 8:00 A.M. on June 13 to review the proposed rule changes . The following rule changes under Administrative Code 4753 were approved by the committee for consideration by the Board:

- 4753-3-04 Educational requirements for licensure.
- 4753-3-05 Student clinical experience requirements.
- 4753-3-09 Reinstatement of license.
- 4753-3-10 Exempt practice; renewal.
- 4753-5-01 Speech-language pathologist or audiologist; fee for initial
- 4753-6-01 Screening.
- 4753-7-01 Licensure of aides.
- 4753-7-02 Supervision requirements; aides.
- 4753-9-01 Code of ethics.

The Committee recommended no change in 4753-3-06 Examination requirements.
The Committee recommended deleting 4753-5-04 Fee for duplicate license certificate.

Motion#16 Ms. Parsons moved to approve the rules changes as recommended by the Rules committee. Dr. Leslie seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

CORRESPONDENCE

Dr. Robert Glaser informed the Board of the use of the term “Audioprosthologist” by hearing aid dealers. The Board is unaware of the use of this term in Ohio, but will have the staff monitor the situation in Ohio.

Dr. Robert Fox sent the Board additional information on the educational background of Jan Stuber an applicant for a conditional license in Speech-Language Pathology.

BOARD BUSINESS

Publication of Disciplinary Actions

Most all of the licensing boards publish disciplinary actions on their licensees. The Board will begin posting disciplinary actions on our web site and note actions on the individual’s license information accessible thru the Ohio E-License website.

Continuing Education

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Ms. DiCesare presented some information on Continuing Education verifications. Given the confusion with some licensees, the Rules committee was directed to review current rules and clarify the rules.

Public Hearing for Rules

The Public Hearing on the proposed rule changes will take place at the September 19, 2005 Board Meeting. This will enable the Rules Committee an opportunity to prepare proposed changes that will be made as a result of the pending law change in Audiology licensure. The Committee will work with the professional organizations in drafting these rule changes.
