Failed to complete the required minimum of 10 hours specific to the clinical practice of speech-language pathology; licensee's request to waive continuing education hours was not granted due to request not substantiating that licensee suffered a personal illness that prevented her from engaging in the active practice of speech-language pathology for at least a majority of the reporting period. Anne M. Hockman	SP.12080	Complete continuing education hours in the area of ethics and documentation related to speech therapy in a school setting. Non compliance will result in suspension of SP licensure until terms are met.	During Supervised Professional Experience (SPE) maintained inadequate documentation of services rendered. On several therapy notes unintentionally documented the wrong date of service for dates either she or a student was absent. Entire SPE repeated with new employer.	May 11, 2016
Tarah N. Lewis	COND.2016157	License Suspended - twenty-five (25) days during completion of second 36 week Supervised Professional Experience (SPE). SPE Report/Contacts Log due within 30 days of completing second fulltime experience.	SPE Plan (Plan) received 258 days late. Reported completion of 36 fulltime weeks of experience; however, only 31 weeks were completed working 30 hours per week. Entire SPE repeated with new employer; at the start of new employment, practiced under conditional license for 49 days unsupervised and not under an approved Plan.
