61 ▪ Dr. Gleason announced that she will not seek reappointment to the Board
62 (expired 8-26-08). She agreed to serve on the Board an additional 60
63 days.

PRINCIPAL ASSISTANT ATTORNEY GENERAL'S REPORT

67 ▪ AAG Tertel was out on medical leave for a brief period of time; however,
68 she indicated the summer was rather slow.

69

70 ▪ AAG Tertel has met with the Interim Executive Director and Investigator
71 for case review. Additional meetings will be scheduled.

73 ▪ No cases will be presented at this meeting. Need to schedule a case
74 review with replacement on Review Committee for Dr. Gleason.

76 ▪ Old and pending cases are being examined to determine viability and are
77 proceeding.

79 ▪ The investigations department is not in a "good place" but meetings will
80 continue and progress is expected.

82 ▪ AAG Tertel will report back to OT/PT about the "3rd option".

84 ▪ Restructuring is occurring at the Attorney General's office and the turn-
85 over rate has increased. A new Assistant Attorney General has been
86 assigned to the SLPAUD Board.

- 95 ▪ Miscommunication with Central Services concerning travel expense

- 99 ▪ Director Lightfoot discussed the possibility of using new case
100 management system for investigative information. This system is already
101 designed and in place at ODPS. This new system would be beneficial in
102 many ways and would facilitate report writing and record retention and
103 retrieval.

106 been unable to locate current PD's for any position and DAS records
107 section advised they have none on file for SLPAUD personnel.

110 of work produced, much of which is behind the scenes and not readily
111 observed by public and licensees. It was noted that, in the future,
112 additional staffing should be considered to enhance efficiency and allow
113 employees to more closely adhere to their prescribed job duties.
