**ASSISTANT ATTORNEY GENERAL'S REPORT**

Mr. Chieffo, Assistant Attorney General for the Board, reported that a hearing will be conducted on April 10 and 11, 2007.

Mr. Chieffo discussed the issue of public records requests for investigatory documents. He recommended that the Board consider incorporating language in ORC 4753 to exclude investigatory documents from public disclosure. This provision is found in the statutes of the Medical Board, Dental Board, and Respiratory Care Board.

Minutes March 22, 2007

Kelly O'Reilly addressed the Board on the draft of the revisions to ORC 4753. A draft was received yesterday and is under review by the working group. Ms. O'Reilly requested that the Board submit changes by tomorrow for submission to the Legislative Services Commission for a rewrite. The amendments to ORC 4753 will be submitted as House and Senate Bills that will come out of the House Education Committee and the Senate Education Committee. Both House and Senate Committees will meet on the amendments concurrently and will hear public testimony on the amendments to ORC 4753.

Ms. O'Reilly discussed the issue of incorporating language in ORC 4753 to protect the confidentiality of investigatory records of the Board. This issue would be better addressed in a budget bill as opposed to placing it in the current proposed bill.

Mr. Setty reported that the year to date expenses continue to be under budgeted projections by \$4,700. Revenues for FY 2007 through February are \$736,480.

The State FY 2008-2009 Budget (HB119) has been submitted by the governor. 2008-2009 Budget Hearings will be held in the next week with the Primary and Secondary Education Committee in the House of Representatives. Mr. Setty will testify on March 27, 2007 at 7:00 P.M. The Governor's budget recommendation supports expenditures of \$431,600 for FY 2008 and \$453,000 for FY 2009 for the Board's operating budget.

Mr. Setty requested Board authorization to purchase four telephones for the office to improve telephone service.

Mr. Setty reported on the meal freeze issued by the governor. Guidelines for meals during Board meetings will be issued by April 5, 2007.
